

Appendix A

Supplemental Playing Rules for Deferred Competitions

(to be read in conjunction with the Joint Interdistrict Playing Rules)

These rules are to be in force if there is a need by the Joint Zones to alter competitions from the normal scheduled Winter Season of Football. If a conflict occurs between these rules and the normal Joint Interdistrict Rules, these rules will take precedence.

- 1. Registration Cut-Off
 - 1.1. No registration will be accepted after 5.00pm on the last <u>scheduled</u> day of Round 7 of the altered Competition
 - 1.2. This cut-off date also includes any Deregistrations for the altered season.
- 2. Rescheduling of Wash Out, Deferred, Abandoned Fixtures
 - 2.1. In the event of a fixture being washed out, deferred or abandoned the score will be recorded as 1-1.
- 3. Mid-Week Games
 - 3.1. In the event fixtures need to be scheduled mid-week, these games will take preference over training.
 - 3.2. Where possible mid-week games will be allocated in the original draw.
- 4. Forfeits
 - 4.1. All forfeits will be reviewed by the Joint Competition Administrators and if necessary, will be referred to the Joint Competition Administrator (Disciplinary)
- 5. Kick Off Times
 - 5.1. In the event that a Kick Off time has to be changed every attempt will be made by the Competition Administrator to notify the Teams/Match Officials involved. The decision of the Competition Administrator for the new time is final.
- 6. Final Series
 - 6.1. The choice of whether a Final Series will be played will be dependent on the time available for the deferred competition
 - 6.2. The Joint Board will determine whether a Final Series will be held prior to the commencement of the competition



- 7. Competition Winners
 - 7.1. In the event there is no Final Series the winners of the Competitions will be decided by who comes first on the table (Premiers)
 - 7.2. Gold medals will be awarded to the Premiers
- 8. Special Conditions
 - 8.1. If warranted, any special regulations that are required for the deferred competitions, these will be distributed to Clubs prior to the season start.

- 8. COVID Rules 2020
 - 8.1. All COVID-19 Safety Plan regulations are to be observed. If in doubt they are to be referred to.
 - 8.2. Participants are to arrive 15 minutes prior to kick off time and leave immediately at the conclusion of the game.
 - 8.3. Teams will not walk out together at the commencement of the game.
 - 8.4. There will be no shaking of hands
 - 8.5. Spitting in any form will be prohibited
 - 8.6. Team Sheets
 - 8.6.1. Will be filled in by one Team official, using their own pen. No player signatures required.
 - 8.6.2. The Referee will use the Team Sheet to record scores, cards etc and then return to Home Club
 - 8.6.3.Home Club will record match scores in SportsTG and then forward Team Sheets onto Macquarie Football as per normal procedure.
 - 8.6.4.No need for signature by Team Official at end of game. Any queries by the teams can be forwarded through the Club to your Zone Office and the Competition Administrator – Disciplinary via email.
 - 8.7. Players are to arrive at Ground dressed ready to play. Change Rooms may/may not be available but there will be limitations on the number of people that can enter the change rooms at any one time.
 - 8.8. Social Distancing will be enforced in the Bench Area. Interchange/Substitute Players will observe the 1.5 m rule
 - 8.9. Bibs for bench players should not be used.
 - 8.10. Goal celebrations will be kept to a minimum.
